Petition Packet Instructions

During the circulation period, if you have any questions or need help, please don't hesitate to contact the Elections' staff. They are available to help in anyway they can prior to the filing period. 815-895-7147

The required forms needed for filing are in this packet and are PDF fillable forms. The Elections' Office staff ask you to utilize our forms; the information is easier to read when typed and will ensure less mistakes when entering data for the ballot setup.

Please read through the entire document before you begin your data entry.

All forms are built around a "full term" for an office. If you are running for an unexpired term, you must make sure that all the appropriate areas are completed with that information.

The heading of the nomination petition pages must include information relative to the election, the candidate, the office, political party, and the candidate's place of residence. The headings on any particular page must be completed prior to circulation of that petition and the heading on each sheet shall be the same.

Only 1 circulator may circulate a petition and must witness all signatures placed upon the petition.

Each candidate must complete and file a Statement of Candidacy. The form of the candidate's name, as printed and signed, should match the name as printed on the petition. The address of the candidate, office sought, party designation, and qualifying statements should also match the information printed on the petition.

Standard procedure is to have the candidate's name spelled the same throughout all the required forms.

A check off sheet is included in the packet; it is suggested that you utilize this form before you file your Petition Packet to ensure that you have completed all necessary forms before you come to the office to file.

Please note: Once the petition packet has been filed it cannot be modified, altered or added to in any way; with one exception, the Statement of Economic Interests receipt may be filed and added to the packet by the close of petition filing.

STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS STATE OF ILLINOIS

ARTICLE 29B FAIR CAMPAIGN PRACTICES ACT

10 ILCS 5/29B-5. Purpose. The Legislature hereby declares that the purpose of this Article is to encourage every candidate for public office in this State to subscribe to the Code of Fair Campaign Practices. It is the intent of the Legislature that every candidate for public office in this State who subscribes to the Code of Fair Campaign Practices will follow the basic principles of decency, honesty and fair play in order to encourage healthy competition and open discussion of issues and candidate qualifications and discourage practices that cloud issues or unfairly attack opponent. (Source: P.A. 86-873.)

10 ILCS 5/29B-10. Code of Fair Campaign Practices. At the time a political committee, as defined in Article 9, files its statement of organization, the State Board of Elections, in the case of a state political committee or a political committee acting as both a state political committee and a local political committee, or the county clerk, in the case of a local political committee, shall give the political committee a blank form of the Code of Fair Campaign Practices and a copy of the provisions of this Article. The State Board of Elections or county clerk shall inform each political committee that subscription to the Code is voluntary. The text of the code shall read:

CODE OF FAIR CAMPAIGN PRACTICES

There are basic principles of decency, honesty, and fair play that every candidate for public office in the State of Illinois has a moral obligation to observe and uphold, in order that, after vigorously contested but fairly conducted campaigns, our citizens may exercise their constitutional right to a free and untrammeled choice and the will of the people may be fully and clearly expressed on the issues.

THEREFORE:

- (1) I will conduct my campaign openly and publicly, and limit attacks on my opponent to legitimate challenges to his record.
- (2) I will not use or permit the use of character defamation, whispering campaigns, libel, slander, or scurrilous attacks on any candidate or his personal or family life.
- (3) I will not use or permit any appeal to negative prejudice based on race, sex, sexual orientation, religion or national origin.
- (4) I will not use campaign material of any sort that misrepresents, distorts, or otherwise falsifies the facts, nor will I use malicious or unfounded accusations that aim at creating or exploiting doubts, without justification, as to the personal integrity or patriotism of my opposition.
- (5) I will not undertake or condone any dishonest or unethical practice that tends to corrupt or undermine our American system of free elections or that hampers or prevents the full and free expression of the will of the voters.
- (6) I will defend and uphold the right of every qualified American voter to full and equal participation in the electoral process.
- (7) I will immediately and publicly repudiate methods and tactics that may come from others that I have pledged not to use or condone. I shall take firm action against any subordinate who violates any provision of this Code or the laws governing elections.

I, the undersigned, candidate for election to public office in the State of Illinois or chairman of a political committee in support of or opposition to a question of public policy, hereby voluntarily endorse, subscribe to, and solemnly pledge myself to conduct my campaign in accordance with the above principles and practices.

SIGNATURE REQUIREMENTS AND FILING DATES

GENERAL PRIMARY – MARCH 19, 2024

First day to circulate Primary Petitions: September 5, 2023

The filing period for Primary Petitions: November 27 – December 4, 2023

(For established political parties)

All petitions must be filed in the office of the County Clerk no later than 5:00 P.M. on Monday, December 4, 2023. Attached to the petition should be a <u>Statement of Candidacy</u> signed by the candidate and notarized. Additionally, a <u>receipt for the Economic Interest</u> <u>Statement</u> must be filed with the petition by the end of the filing period. (Exception – Precinct Committeemen are not required to file an Economic Interest Statement.)

Signature Requirements: County Wide Candidates

Democrat - 124 (Minimum)

Republican – 135 (Minimum)

(For all offices, petitions must be signed by at least .5% (.005) of the votes cast for any candidate of the party who received the highest number of votes in the <u>county</u> at the last General Election (November 8, 2022). The party candidate with the highest vote in the county could be any Federal, State, or County Candidate.

[10ILCS 5/7-10 (c)]

Democrat – Amanda Christensen – 24,732 x .005 = 123.66 --- **124 signatures**

Republican – Andy Sullivan – 26,907 x .005 = 134.535 --- **135 signatures**

Signature Requirements – <u>County Board Candidates</u>

Democrat and Republican – 25 Minimum

(For offices elected by District, petitions must be signed by at least .5% (.005) of the qualified electors of the party in the entire county who cast votes at the last preceding General Election (November 8, 2022) <u>divided</u> by the number of County Board districts, but in no event shall the number of signatures be less than 25.

[10 ILCS 5/7 - 10 (c)]

Signature Requirements – Precinct Committee Persons

Democrat and Republican – 10 Minimum

(A minimum of 10 signatures of primary electors of the party for the precinct. [10 ILCS 5/7 - 10 (i)]
