### **Petition Packet Instructions**

During the circulation period, if you have any questions or need help, please don't hesitate to contact the Elections' staff. They are available to help in any way they can prior to the filing period. 815-895-7147

The required forms needed for filing are in this packet and are PDF fillable forms. The Elections' Office staff ask you to utilize our forms; the information is easier to read when typed and will ensure less mistakes when entering data for the ballot setup.

Please read through the entire document before you begin your data entry.

All forms are built around a "full term" for an office. If you are running for an unexpired term, you must make sure that all the appropriate areas are completed with that information.

The heading of the nomination petition pages must include information relative to the election, the candidate, the office, political party, and the candidate's place of residence. The headings on any particular page must be completed prior to circulation of that petition and the heading on each sheet shall be the same.

Only 1 circulator may circulate a petition and must witness all signatures placed upon the petition.

Each candidate must complete and file a Statement of Candidacy. The form of the candidate's name, as printed and signed, should match the name as printed on the petition. The address of the candidate, office sought, party designation, and qualifying statements should also match the information printed on the petition.

Standard procedure is to have the candidate's name spelled the same throughout all the required forms.

A check off sheet is included in the packet; it is suggested that you utilize this form before you file your Petition Packet to ensure that you have completed all necessary forms before you come to the office to file.

Please note: Once the petition packet has been filed it cannot be modified, altered or added to in any way; with one exception, the Statement of Economic Interests receipt may be filed and added to the packet by the close of petition filing.

Dear Precinct Committeeperson Candidate,

My office staff and I would like to congratulate you on your decision to serve the public as a representative of your party. If you have already been serving as a Committeeperson, thank you for continuing your service. After your County Convention and as a newly sworn in Precinct Committeeperson you will have a responsibility, regarding the Elections' office, that is essential to DeKalb County Residents for fair and secure elections.

Providing a list of names for individuals wishing to be Election Judges representing your party, is one of the most important jobs that you and your Party Chairperson will do for my office. Our goal is to staff each Precincts, with <u>at least</u>, 5 Election Judges on Election Day. We not only utilize individuals on Election Day, we also train some judges to work during Early Voting and as Election Day Registration Judges utilizing our Voter Registration program. Over the last several years we have had many of our judges retire or move out of state; which has had a negative effect on the size of our list and reduced the number of alternates available.

During your petition circulating process, whether you are obtaining signatures for yourself or another candidate, you might find it easier to locate Election Judges rather than waiting until this summer. Below are the qualifications needed to be an Election Judge:

- Be a registered voter in DeKalb County
- 👍 Able to perform the 4 basic functions of math
- 🖶 Must speak and write the English language
- Available for every election during the next 2-year cycle

Those interested may fill out a copy of the attached Election Judge Application, visit our website at: dekalbcountyclerkil.gov, contact the office at 815-895-7147 or elections@dekalbcounty.org. Training sessions take place before every election for all new judges and are also available as a refresher course for experienced judges.

High School Juniors and Seniors, and students at NIU, who are not registered to vote in DeKalb County, are also able to serve an Election Judges. The must follow a slightly different program, obtain permission from their school, parent/guardian and have at least a 3.0 g.p.a. If you have children or grandchildren, who might be interested, please have them contact the office to serve. Students in this program are not eligible to be appointed by a party, but do represent their chosen party.

- > Assist with closing procedures and packing of election supplies (until approximately 8:30PM)

## SIGNATURE REQUIREMENTS AND FILING DATES

# GENERAL PRIMARY – MARCH 17, 2026

First day to circulate Primary Petitions: August 5, 2025

The filing period for Primary Petitions: October 27 – November 3, 2025

(For established political parties)

All petitions must be filed in the office of the County Clerk no later than 5:00 P.M. on Monday, November 3, 2025. Attached to the petition should be a <u>Statement of Candidacy</u> signed by the candidate and notarized. Additionally, a <u>receipt for the Economic Interest</u> <u>Statement</u> must be filed with the petition by the end of the filing period. (Exception – Precinct Committeemen are not required to file an Economic Interest Statement.)

Signature Requirements: County Wide Candidates

Democratic - 118 (Minimum)

## Republican – 136 (Minimum)

(For all offices, petitions must be signed by at least .5% (.005) of the votes cast for any candidate of the party who received the highest number of votes in the <u>county</u> at the last General Election (November 8, 2022). The party candidate with the highest vote in the county could be any Federal, State, or County Candidate.

[10ILCS 5/7-10 (c)]

**Democrat** – Joseph R. Biden – 23,648 x .005 = 118.24 --- **118 signatures** 

**Republican** – Lori Grubbs – 27,256 x .005 = 136.28 --- 136 signatures

Signature Requirements – <u>County Board Candidates</u>

## Democratic and Republican – 25 Minimum

(For offices elected by District, petitions must be signed by at least .5% (.005) of the qualified electors of the party in the entire county who cast votes at the last preceding General Election (November 5, 2024) <u>divided</u> by the number of County Board districts, but in no event shall the number of signatures be less than 25.

[10 ILCS 5/7 - 10 (c)]

Signature Requirements – Precinct Committee Persons

# Democrat and Republican – 10 Minimum

(A minimum of 10 signatures of primary electors of the party for the precinct. [10 ILCS 5/7 - 10 (i)]
