

A self-checklist for potential Candidates

Running for office is exciting, but it comes with real responsibilities. Use this checklist to reflect before you commit:

✓ Personal Readiness
\Box I have the time to attend regular meetings and events (evenings/weekends).
☐ My family and employer support my decision to run and serve.
\square I am comfortable with being a public figure and open to scrutiny.
☐ I can commit to reading and preparing for board packets, budgets, and policy documents.
✓ Motivation & Goals
☐ I know why I want to serve (specific issues, values, or improvements).
☐ I am focused on helping my community, not just opposing someone else.
☐ I am willing to collaborate with people who may disagree with me.
✓ Campaign Basics
☐ I understand how to circulate and file petitions correctly.
☐ I am aware of campaign finance rules (>\$5,000 requires a committee).
☐ I have thought about how I will fund a campaign (self-fund, donations, fundraising).
\square I have at least one or two trusted people who can help (campaign treasurer, volunteers).
✓ Ethical & Legal Awareness
☐ I understand that decisions must follow laws, not personal interests.
☐ I am aware of the Open Meetings Act and FOIA.
☐ I am prepared to recuse myself if conflicts of interest arise.
